The future of agricultural, environment and rural policies in Wales

The Climate Change, Environment and Rural Affairs Committee ('the Committee') at the National Assembly for Wales is currently undertaking an inquiry into the future of agricultural, environment and rural policies in Wales.

On Wednesday 9 November 2016, I am making a statement to the Assembly on behalf of the Committee to update Assembly Members on progress with this work.

As part of this statement, I will be calling on the UK Government to commit to providing Wales with the same level of funding for agriculture, environment and rural development as is currently provided by the European Union.

I will also call on the UK Government to recognise that these areas are devolved and, as such, Wales must have the freedom to determine future policy in these areas.

As a Committee, we are supportive of the bilateral talks that are being held between the Welsh and UK Government and the multilateral talks involving all the devolved governments. We recognise that some level of UK-wide framework for agricultural policy is an option. However, we believe that any such framework should be agreed between the devolved nations and the UK Government and subject to the scrutiny and consent of the devolved assemblies and parliaments.
